Dear Sir/ Madam,

With reference to your application for the purpose mentioned in the subject cited above, I am directed to inform you that on the basis of the Inspection Committee report and as per recommendations of the Board of Inspection (BOI) dated 26.06.2023 constituted for this purpose, the University has decided to grant extension of provisional affiliation to your college in the course mentioned below for the academic session 2023-24, for the seats mentioned against the said course.

If the college already has a valid approval of BCI from the session 2023-24, it can start the process of admissions against the approved seats immediately after issuance of this letter and in case the college does not have the approval of BCI for the session 2023-24, it is mandatorily required to obtain the BCI approval, or to deposit the requisite fee to BCI, within one month of issuance of this letter, for its inspection/approval for the session 2023-24 and proof of the same should be submitted to the University. The admission process can be started on compliance of the same.

	LL.M. (2yrs)	40 Seats (One Section) Fresh provisional Affiliation is granted for the Session 2023-24.	

Note: -

1. The college should strictly follow the admission guidelines and syllabus prescribed by the University for all Law Courses, available on the university website.
2. The medium of instruction shall be English for Five Years Integrated Law Programme.
3. College has Applied for fresh affiliation for B.A.LL.B.(5yrs.) course for the session 2023-24.
4. College has Applied for fresh affiliation for LL.M.(2yrs.) course for the session 2023-24.

Accordingly, the college is required to adhere to the following:

- That if the college already has a valid approval of BCI for the session 2023-24, it can start the process of admissions against the approved seats immediately after issuance of this letter.

- That if the college does not have the valid approval of BCI for the session 2023-24, it is mandatorily required to obtain the BCI approval, or to deposit the requisite fee to BCI, within one month of issuance of this letter, for its inspection/approval for the session 2023-24 and proof of the same should be submitted to the University. The admission process can be started on compliance of the same.
- That the necessary compliance with regard to remarks/recommendations made by the Inspection Committee must be ensured within the prescribed time limit, failing which, the proposal of the college for affiliation for the session 2024-25 will not be considered.
- That the university by virtue of its authority may exercise the powers to inspect the college any time and if found violating the above-mentioned norms, the college will be liable to face the consequences. That the proposals for Affiliation for the Academic Session 2024-25 will be invited in December, 2023.
- The provision of 10% (Ten Percent) seats for EWS category for BA LL.B. and LL.B. courses will be in accordance to the policy of Bar Council India (BCI) and with specific approval sought from the BCI by the college.
